### **Data Protection**

The new **European General Data Protection Regulations** (GDPR) starts on 25th May 2018, stating contact with you by any media may only be made with your prior consent. For example, no longer will it be possible to send out emails to anyone in the church family until their new consent is received. Nor is it acceptable to assume consent just because no 'opt-out' request has been received or because the church happen to have someone's email address already in the church computer.

Parishes must maintain lists showing which people have given their consent to be contacted by any media, for any reason and therefore to hold your data securely. You can restrict the type of the media the church can use to keep you informed as you will see on the Consent form you are being asked to complete. Please read the detail on this form carefully.

Please complete the Consent form and return it to a sides-person at a church service or the church office. You will be responsible to keep the church office advised of any changes to your data.
